

Deadline Extended for Commenting on Grizzly Bear Restoration!



Thanks to dedicated efforts by all of the supporters of the North Cascades grizzly bear reintroduction (including you, our wonderful volunteers who helped raise awareness with the grizzly bear cart) the National Parks Service has extended the comment deadline to April 28th! Please continue to educate our visitors about the environmental impact statement, and encourage people comment or sign their names when you are out with the grizzly bear cart.

One of the main goals that we surpassed was 50,000 comments. According to The Oatmeal blog, this was not just an arbitrary number. The Department of the Interior uses social pressure to gauge public interest in a project. The National Wildlife Federation has done multiple campaigns similar to this one, and they estimated that 50k comments is the amount it would take for this program to get on the DOI's radar. As Of March 13th the comment page passed 100,000 comments total, which is a main reason why the comment period was extended.
